That's what Bush Kambi is all about!

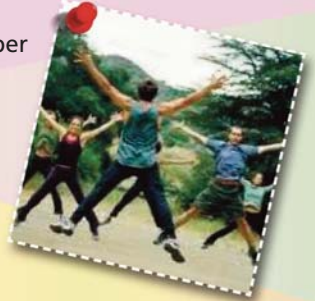

Kambi Kids Rustenburg

Kambi Kids Rustenburg is hosted at the Oppiberg Lodge. Oppiberg is situated in next to the beautiful Magaliesburg Mountains and close to the Buffelspoort Dam. Accommodation is 8 rooms that sleep 4 people each.

Itinerary

Day One

Meet at Northgate Shopping Center at 9:00 where you will be transferred to Oppiberg Rustenburg. (Transfers are available at an additional cost or you can drop your children off at the venue directly. All children must be at Oppiberg by no later than 10:30 on day of arrival).

Upon arrival at the lodge you will be allocated to your room to unpack your belongings. Then we will gather at the central boma for a social "meet and greet" with your fellow team mates and be divided to your Kambi Teams. Then, it's time to use those imaginations to make team flags and mascots, which will represent you through out your stay at Kambi Kids.

Break for a delicious lunch.

Following your meal the competition begins with an Air riflery course. Air rifles are easy to fire, and riflery can be fun and rewarding! Together with your instructors you will be required to shoot down your targets and those that get the most hits will gain the most points for your team.

This activity will take up most of the afternoon and following the course you will have some down time to get ready for dinner and a bonfire under the stars.

Day Two

An early morning wake up call awaits you on day two. Enjoy breakfast and then it is time for a morning hike through the bush. Together with your guide you will explore the natural fauna and flora of the area and learn more about your natural surroundings.

When you are all done meet on our field for an exciting day - You will enjoy a game of Human Foosball - Human Foosball is the craziest game to get your team working together. The game takes regular foosball game play and makes it life-sized. Players are attached to a pole, so they all have to work together moving side to side, trying to kick the soccer ball.

Break for lunch

An inflatable obstacle course follows so get ready for combat as you challenge your opponent to the ultimate challenge! What tactics will you use when you jump through your first hole and squeeze through the inflated pillars only to be met up with hedgehogs? You better have upper body strength to grab the rope and swing to the other side, or whoops... you'll get wet! As you go through the vertical pillars, watch out... Lazer Beams! Are you tired yet? You still must face another obstacle before climbing your way to the top and sliding to victory!



Ending off an exciting day with a competition of inflatable power save. With the Speed Shot, the player tests the power of their shot by shooting into the inflatable cage. A state of the art radar gives an accurate reading in KPH and a digital visual display unit provides a clear reading of their shot. Challenge yourself to better your last attempt and score points for your team.

After a very full and fun day it is time to relax and enjoy a delicious braai. Milo to follow and time to roast some marshmallows before bed.

Day Three

Another full and fun day awaits you so after a filling breakfast it is time to meet for a morning of abseiling, ziplines and rock climbing. These exciting activities will take up most of the day but there will be a break for lunch.

There is no sense of failure for those who do not climb or participate in the adventure activities. There are real and meaningful support roles within the team as they assist with ropes and encouragement of their team mates to make it to the top.

Late afternoon allows for the fantastic challenge of shelter building. Building a shelter using the materials that are on hand is a valuable skill for anyone who spends time camping or hiking. Teaching young people to build shelters can give them confidence and help build their self esteem.

Day Four

Today is all about connecting as a group and enjoying games that exercise not only the body but also the mind so after a delicious breakfast you will meet for some fun games on the field.

You get started with Air Ball, followed by a Vuvuzela Race, Egg-cercise activity, Dribbling competition, Header competition, Hula Hoop challenge and finally Shelter building. You will break for lunch between the events and after dinner you will enjoy night games consisting of stalk the lantern, Fort attack and more.

Day Five

This morning you will wake up for breakfast and enjoy a stunning bush walk through the bush, This is an opportunity to learn more about the incredible Fauna and Flora found just on your doorstep but pay attention to your surroundings as today you will be orienteering through this very bushveld. You will be required to "Find the hidden treasure" using clues provided on your control card and using a compass, map and directions you will have to find your way from one clue to the next in order to find your prize at the end.

After you have found all the clues and discovered your prize you will meet back at the boma for lunch following which it is time for afternoon messy games and archery.

After a full day it is time for dinner after which you will enjoy an incredible evening of stargazing. A mobile unit will move in bringing with them a huge telescope in which to view the night skies where you have the opportunity to view the stars & constellations, planets, the moon, comets and whatever heavenly bodies may be visible.

Astronomers on site are qualified and experienced presenters who are capable of combining astronomy, African star lore and local myths and legends to make astronomy interesting for everyone - A fantastic way to end of an amazing day!



Day Six

As it is your last morning at Kambi Kids you will enjoy a full English breakfast. Following a delicious meal it is time for prize giving where you will earn individual awards and well as team awards for activities well done.

After packing up your belongings you will bid your team farewell and make your way back home - Taking with you memories that will last a lifetime!
